

E S Matthews' Addition "A" to Starke.

Being a portion of the following described lands Deeded by Jessie Haganman to Eugene S. Matthews, March 28, 1900 and recorded in Book "B" of Deeds page 271 et seq., in the Court House in Starke Florida, to wit:

Beginning at a post on the West side of Walnut Street, where the North line of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 28 Township 6 North Range 22 East crosses the West side of said street; thence southerly along the West side of said street 170 1/4 feet; thence westerly at right angles to said Walnut Street 493 feet; thence northerly and parallel to said Walnut Street 6 1/2 feet to said North line of said Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter, thence east to place of beginning containing one acre more or less.

Also.

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated in the Town of Starke, Bradford County, Florida, described as follows:

Beginning at a post on the West side of Walnut Street 170 1/4 feet southerly from where the North line of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 58 Township 6 South Range 22 East crosses the West side of said street; thence westerly and at right angles to said street 493 feet; thence southerly and parallel to said street 237 1/4 feet; thence easterly and at right angles to Walnut Street 493 feet to West side
