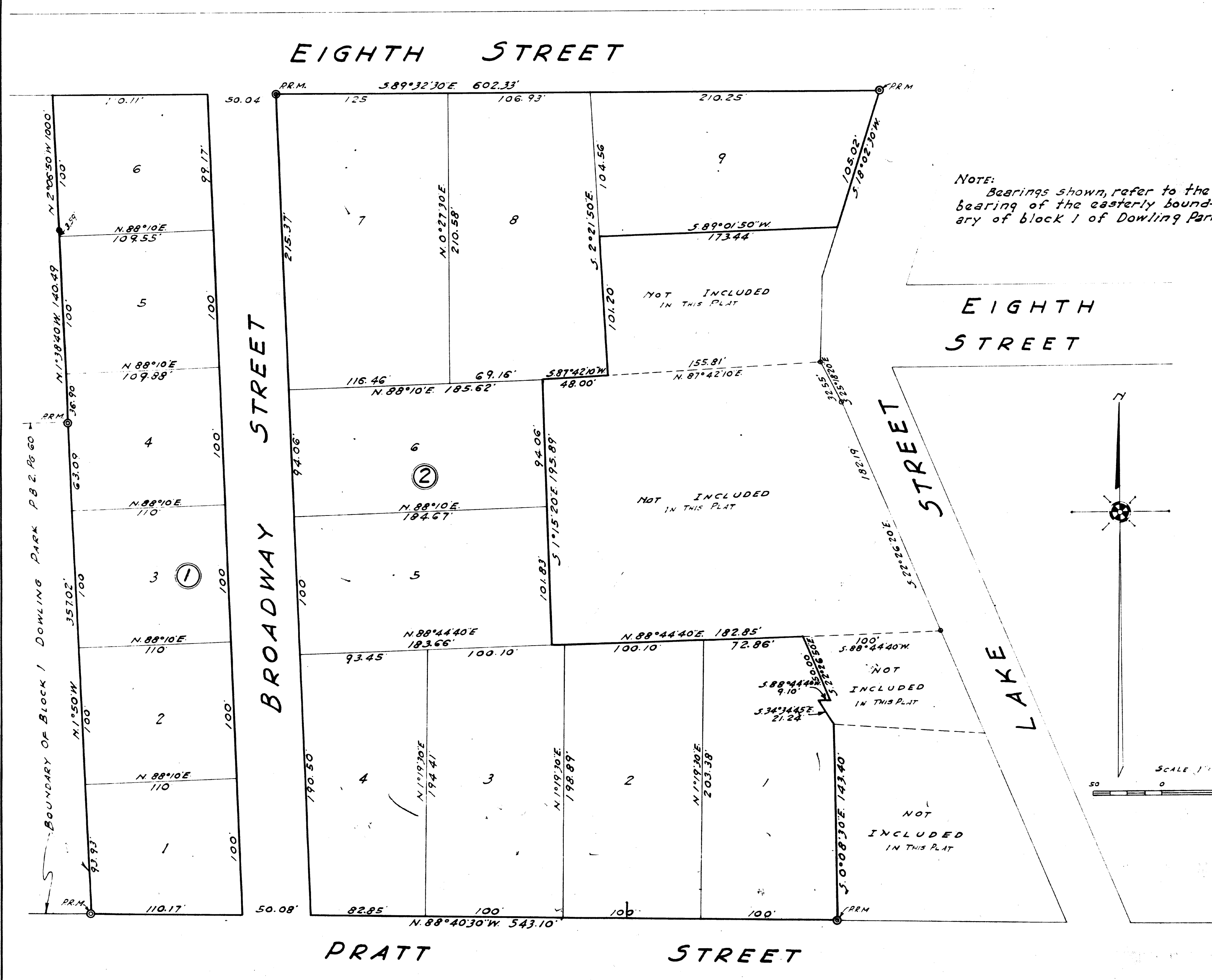


# WHITE ACRES

CAPTION:

Commence at a permanent reference monument at the southeasterly corner of block 1 of Dowling Park, according to plat recorded in Plat Book 2, page 60, of the public records of Bradford County, Florida, for point of beginning. From point of beginning thus described, run North one (1) degree and fifty (50) minutes West along the Easterly boundary of said block one (1), a distance of three hundred fifty seven and two hundredths (357.02) feet to a permanent reference monument on the northeasterly corner of said block one (1); run then North one (1) degree, thirty eight (38) minutes and forty (40) seconds west a distance of one hundred forty and forty nine hundredths (140.49) feet to an iron stake; run thence North two (2) degrees, six (6) minutes and fifty (50) seconds West, a distance of one hundred (100) feet to an iron stake on the southerly boundary of the right of way of Eighth Street; run thence South eighty nine (89) degrees thirty two (32) minutes and thirty (30) seconds East along said southerly boundary, a distance of six hundred two and thirty three hundredths (602.33) feet to a permanent reference monument at its intersection with the westerly boundary of Lake Street; run thence South eighteen (18) degrees, two (2) minutes and thirty (30) seconds West along said westerly boundary a distance of one hundred five and two hundredths (105.02) feet to an iron stake; run thence South eighty nine (89) degrees, one (1) minute and fifty (50) seconds west a distance of one hundred seventy three and forty four hundredths (173.44) feet to an iron stake; run thence South two (2) degrees, twenty one (21) minutes and fifty (50) seconds East, a distance of one hundred one and two tenths (101.2) feet to an iron stake; run thence South eighty seven (87) degrees, forty two (42) minutes and ten (10) seconds West a distance of forty eight (48) feet to an iron stake; run thence South one (1) degree, fifteen (15) minutes and twenty (20) seconds East, a distance of one hundred ninety five and eighty nine hundredths (195.89) feet to an iron stake; run thence North eighty eight (88) degrees, forty four (44) minutes and forty (40) seconds East, a distance of one hundred eighty two and eighty five hundredths (182.85) feet to an iron stake; run thence South twenty two (22) degrees, twenty six (26) minutes and fifty (50) seconds East, a distance of fifty (50) feet to an iron stake; run thence South eighty eight (88) degrees, forty four (44) minutes and forty (40) seconds west, a distance of nine and one tenth (9.1) feet to an iron stake; run thence South thirty four (34) degrees, thirty four (34) minutes and forty five (45) seconds East, a distance of twenty one and twenty four hundredths (21.24) feet to an iron stake; run thence South zero (0) degrees, eight (8) minutes and thirty (30) seconds east a distance of one hundred forty three and four tenths (143.4) feet to a permanent reference monument on the Northerly boundary of the right of way of Pratt Street; run thence North eighty eight (88) degrees, forty (40) minutes and thirty (30) seconds west along said Northerly boundary a distance of five hundred forty three and one tenth (543.1) feet to point of beginning.
